**WEATHER FORECAST**

**DATE: WEDNESDAY 05<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY, 2025**

**TONIGHT:** Slight haze and cool with breezy condition will prevail over the country.

**TOMORROW:** Cool and breezy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming slightly hazy and sunny during the period.

**WINDS:** Will mainly be northeasterly flow across the country with speed ranging from 09 – 26 km/h.

**TEMPERATURES:** The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 15°C over the North Bank and Upper River Region, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 37°C over Upper River Region.

**SUNRISE AND SUNSET:** The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 07:22 AM and over Greater Banjul area at 07: 32 AM, and will set at 06:59 PM and 07:09 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul area respectively.
