MARINE FORECAST (FISHING)

DATE: TUESDAY 18TH MARCH, 2025.

VALIDITY: FOR 24 HOURS FROM 1800UTC, TUESDAY 18TH TO WEDNESDAY 19TH MARCH 2025.

SEA SAFETY ADVISORY ALERT: Rough sea with significant wave heights of (2.8m) and strong winds of (33km/h) will prevail over The Gambia territorial waters from Today 1800Z to Sunday 1200Z 23rd March 2025.

The wind force and wave heights will continue to be rough especially over the offshore areas. These conditions will continue until 1200Z Sunday 23rd March, 2025.

Fishermen and other users at the sea are advised to use maximum sea safety regulations at all fishing landing sites during the period.

INSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: *Up to 20 Nautical miles (37km) inside the Sea*

Winds: Will vary between westerly and northerly flow with speed ranging from 13 - 33 km/h.

Wave Height: will be 1.1 – 2.5 meters high.

Sea State: Slight to moderate

Weather: Slight haze

Visibility: Moderate

OFFSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: *From 20 up to 200 Nautical Miles (37km - 370km) into the high Sea*

Winds: Will be northerly flow with speed ranging from 15 - 33 km/h.

Wave Height: Will be 2.4- 2.7 meters high.

Sea State: Moderate to rough

Weather: Slight haze

Visibility: Moderate
